## VETERAN EXEMPTION TO NON-RESIDENT TUITION RATE

Per University of Hawaii Board of Regents Policy RP 6.208 Board Exemptions to Non-Resident Tuition, the student may be exempted from the non-resident tuition rate if:

- (a) Veteran eligible to use Post 9/11 GI Bill® (chapter 33) or Montgomery GI Bill® Active Duty (chapter 30) educational benefits, who lives in Hawaii, and enrolls at the University within three years of discharge from a period of active duty service of 90 days or more OR
- (b) Individual eligible to use transferred Post 9/11 GI Bill® (chapter 33) or Montgomery GI Bill® Active Duty (chapter 30) educational benefits, who lives in Hawaii, and enrolls at the University within three years of the transferor's discharge from a period of active duty service of 90 days or more OR
- (c) Individual eligible to use transferred Post 9/11 GI Bill® (chapter 33) educational benefits, who lives in Hawaii, and whose transferor is a member of the uniformed services who is serving on active duty OR
- (d) Individual eligible to use Post 9/11 GI Bill® (chapter 33) educational benefits under the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship and who lives in Hawaii, and enrolls at the University within three years of the service member's death in the line of duty following a period of active duty service of 90 days or more

- DD 214 from a and b
- Military Orders from c
- DD 1300 from d

*If I have a break in attendance (stop out), excluding summer term, I understand that I will have to re-apply for admissions and meet the re-enrollment within the three years of discharge (or service member's death for Fry Scholarship). Re-enrollment date shall be the first day of instruction of re-enrollment term.*
