VETERAN EXEMPTION TO NON-RESIDENT TUITION RATE

Per University of Hawaii Board of Regents Policy RP 6.208 Board Exemptions to Non-Resident Tuition, the student may be exempted from the non-resident tuition rate if:

- (a) Veterans eligible to use Post 9/11 GI Bill® (chapter 33) or Montgomery GI Bill® Active Duty (chapter 30) educational benefits, who live in Hawaii, and enroll at the University within three years of discharge from a period of active duty service of 90 days or more OR
- (b) Individuals eligible to use transferred Post 9/11 GI Bill® (chapter 33) or Montgomery GI Bill® Active Duty (chapter 30) educational benefits, who live in Hawaii, and enroll at the University within three years of the transferor's discharge from a period of active duty service of 90 days or more OR
- (c) Individuals eligible to use Post 9/11 GI Bill® (chapter 33) educational benefits under the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship, who live in Hawaii, and enroll at the University within three years of the service member's death in the line of duty following a period of active duty service of 90 days or more
