Me ke kuleana ko ‘iko ‘i e ho ‘ohiki ke Kula nui e kāko ‘o a e ho ‘okumu i ala e hiki ke kokua i ka ho ‘onui ‘ika a nā kānaka maoli. Na mākou nō e ho ‘olako, kāko ‘o a paipai i nā Ko ‘olau a ko O‘ahu a ‘e me nā hana no ‘eau ākea, ka ho ‘ona ‘auao ‘oihana a me ka ho ‘onui ‘ike ma ke kaiāulu – hō ‘a ‘ano a e ho ‘oulu i nā haumāna i ka po ‘okela.

Ka wehewehena papa

He ho‘olauna Hawai‘i kēia, pēlā pū i ka ‘ike Hawai‘i a me ka hana Hawai‘i i loko o ka Pākīpika e la‘a me ka mo‘okū‘auhau Hawai‘i, ka nohona Hawai‘i, ka ‘ōlelo Hawai‘i, ka mo‘olelo Hawai‘i, ‘āina, ka ho‘omana Hawai‘i a me ka hana no‘eau Hawai‘i.

Ka hopena o ke a‘o

I hopena, E ili mai ana ka ‘ike ma lalo iho nei i luna o ka haumāna:

1. E ho‘ohālikelike ‘ia ka mo‘omeheu a me ka mo‘olelo o ka po‘e Pākīpika a me ko lākou pilina i ka ‘ōlelo, ka ho‘omana, ka hana no‘eau, kā lākou hō‘ike ‘ana aku i ia mau mea a pau, a me ka ho‘onui ‘ana a‘e i ka lāhui Hawai‘i.
2. E kuhi i ke kaiāpuni i loli mai ai ka mo‘omeheu Hawai‘i a me ka mo‘omeheu Pākīpika.
3. E wehewehe mai i ke komo ‘ana i ka mo‘omeheu Hawai‘i a me ka mo‘olelo o ka pilina o ka ‘āina a me ka po‘e kānaka ma o ke ‘ōlelo ‘ana a me ke kākau ‘ana.
4. E wehewehe mai i ke ‘ano o ka pilina Hawai‘i ma waena o nā hui o loko a me waho o Hawai‘i nei.
5. E kuhi a loilo i ho‘i i kekahi mau kumu ‘ike Hawai‘i

6. E kuhi i ka hopena o nā pilina a e kūkulu a hā‘awi mana‘o paha i ka holomua ‘ana o ka lāhui Hawai‘i.

Ka hana papa

Ke koina papa and me ka hana o ka papa:

1. Ka heluhelu ‘ana a me ke komo ‘ana i ka wala‘au:

Aia ana nā ha‘awina heluhelu mai loko mai o nā puke/‘atikala. E loa‘a ana i ka haumāna ia mau mea ma ka “Resources” ma Laulima.

2. Ka ho‘okō ‘ana i nā ha‘awina

E hō‘ike ‘ia ana ka wā e ho‘opau mai ai ka haumāna i kēlā me kēia ha‘awina/hō‘ike/kuisa, akā na‘e mai kali a ‘ūlōlohi ka ha‘awina o emi mai ka ‘ai.

3. Nā kuisa palapala ‘āina, nā hō‘ike, a me nā ha‘awina.

Ka ‘ike pili keu

Ka ‘ae ‘ana i ka hana lohi:

- Nā kuisa: ‘A‘ole ‘ae ‘ia ke kuisa lohi, akā na‘e inā he kumu e hana lohi ana i ke kuisa e ho‘omaopopo koke mai ma mua o ke kuisa a i ‘ole e hā‘awi mai i ka palapala kaukau/palapala kūhelu e kuhi ana kou hiki ‘ole ke hana i ke kuisa ma ka pūnaewelete.
- Nā ha‘awina kākau: ‘A‘ole ‘ae ‘ia nā ha‘awina heluhelu a me nā ha‘awina kākau mana‘o. .

Ke kōkua

Inā he pono ke kōkua, mai kali. E nānā iā lalo i nā loulou a i ‘ole nā helu kelepona o nā kānaka e hiki ai ke kōkua iā ‘oe, ma ke kelepona, ma ka pūnaewelete, he alo a he alo, a pēlā wale aku nō.

Ke Kāko‘o i ka Na‘auao (ke kōkua i ka hana papa) Kumu: Na‘u nō e kōkua iā ‘oe i ka hālāwai, ke kelepona, a i ‘ole i ka pūnaewelete. E ha‘i mai ia‘u no ka ho‘opa‘a ‘ana i hālāwai a kāua. (Aia ko‘u ‘ike ma iā luna o kēia palapala.)

Ke Kūlia ‘ana i ka Nu‘u:

- Ke Kāko‘o a ke Tuta (e pili i nā mākau like ‘ole) – aia i ka hale waihona puke a i ‘ole i ke ke‘ena o TRiO SSS
- Ke Kōkua ma ka Hale Waihona Puke – Hiki i nā kahu hale waihona puke ke kōkua i ka ‘imi ‘ana i nā puke, nā mo‘olelo, a me nā mea like ‘ole ma ka pūnaewelete. E kipa i ka hale waihona puke ma Hale La‘akea ke loa‘a ka nīnau.

Ke Olakino o ka Na‘au a me ka No‘ono‘o: Na ke Kikowaena No‘ono‘o Pono e kuauhā kūikawā a kuhikuhi i nā kumu waiwai o ke kaiāulu i ka wā piliki‘i. ‘A‘ohe ho‘ouku, akā he mea hūnā a he mea na ke kanaka e koho. I ho‘opa‘a i ka hālāwai ma ke kahua pūnaewelete nei: No‘ono‘o Pono.

Ke A‘oa‘o Ho‘ona‘auao: Ua hiki i nā haumāna a pau ke noi i ke A‘oa‘o Ho‘ona‘auao no ka ‘imi na‘auao ‘ana, ke koho ‘ana i ka ‘oihana, ka hō‘oia ‘ana i nā pono papahana na‘auao, a me ke koho ‘ana i ke ala kekelē kūpono. E kōkua ana nā Ka‘i A‘oa‘o ma nā koina papahana, ke kulana ma ka papahana a i ‘ole ka hō‘oia komo, ke kulana papa, ke ka‘ina papa, ke kohō papa, ke kākau inoa, ka ho‘ili kula, ka loa‘a o ka helu‘ai ma ka hō‘ike, ka hemo kula a pēlā wale aku! Aia ka ‘ike hou aku a me ka ho‘opa‘a hālāwai ‘ana ma: Ke A‘oa‘o a me ke Kuauhā.

Ke kulekele Kulanui a me nā ki‘ihana

He hui ho‘ohana ‘imina‘auao e kaulike/hō‘oia hana ana ke Kulanui o Hawai‘i. Kūpa‘a nō ia i ke kulekele no ka wae ‘ole a ho‘okae ‘ole ma muli o ka lāhui, ke keka, ka limanui ‘ia, ke ‘ano o ka hō‘ike keka, ka makahiki, ka ho‘omana, ka ‘ili, ka ‘āina hānau, ka mo‘okū‘auhau, ke aupuni kumu, ke kulana hiki ‘ole, ka welo, ke kulana male, ka hānai waiū, ke kulana kālā no ka mālama keiki, ka hopu ‘ia a me ka mo‘olelo ‘aha (koe ka mea e ‘ae ‘ia ma lalo o ke kānāwai moku‘āina), ke ‘ano o ke keka e ‘i‘ini ‘ia, ka hele ‘ole i ke papa ma muli o ka pū‘ali koa, a i ‘ole ka ho‘omaha loa mai ka pū‘ali koa mai. Ho‘omalu kēia kulekele i ka ‘ae komo a me ka hiki ke loa‘a, ke komo piha ‘ana, ka mālama pilina ‘ana, a me ka hai ‘ia ‘ana i loko nō o nā papahana a me nā hana o ke Kulanui nei. Inā ‘oe e mana‘o ana, ua ho‘okae ‘ia, e kelepona i ke Ke‘ena Kaulike a Hō‘oia Hana ma ka helu kelepona 956-7077. E kipa i ke kahua pūnaewelete no ka mana‘o hou aku: Nā Kulekele a me Nā Ka‘inahana Laulā o ke Kulanui o Hawai‘i (PPIS).

No ka Pilikino a me ka Hūnā

I ka nānā ‘ana i ka pilikino, e ho‘omalu ana au i nā mana‘o a me ke kūkākūkā ‘ana a ka haumāna ma loko nō o ka‘u papa, a pēlā pū ka‘u e noi ai i nā haumāna no kekahī i kekahī. ‘O ka mea na‘e ho‘i, e kālailai ‘ia ana paha kēia papa no ka loiilo a me ka paka ‘ana mai. Ke koho ‘ia paha ka papa no kēia hana, e hiki ana i nā kumu kulanui ‘ē a‘e a me nā limahana kulanui ke nānā mai i nā pono papa a me ka wala‘au haumāna. E hūnā ‘ia ana nā kaha, a e ho‘ā‘o nui ana au e hana e like me ka makemake a ka haumāna no ka hūnā ‘ana i kāna hana a me kāna ha‘awina ma ka papa. Akā nō na‘e, inā ‘ike ‘ia ka ho‘oma‘au ‘ana a i‘ole ka hana kūpono ‘ole, he kuleana ko‘u no ka hō‘ike ‘ana aku i ia ‘ano hana i nā alaka‘i kulanui case will be handled. No ke Kūpono o ka Haumāna

E mahu‘i ‘ia ana kou mālama pono ‘ana i ka pilina me ka po‘e a pau o ke kula a me kāu hō‘ihī ‘ana i nā mana‘o ko‘iko‘i a ke Kulanui Kaiāulu o ke Ko‘olau. E kaomi i ka loulou e nānā i ka Puke Kānāwai Haumāna no kekahī ‘ike e pili i kou kuleana haumāna: UH PPIS - EP 7.208 E ho‘opa‘i ‘ia ana paha ka haumāna i ka ‘a‘e ‘ana i kānāwai o ua puke ala, e la‘a: he ‘ōlelo ho‘okekē, he wā ho‘omalu, he uku pāna‘i, he ho‘oku‘u no ka manawa, he kipaku, a i ‘ole he kāpae i nā kaha a i ‘ole ke kekele. No ka ‘Oia‘i‘o ma ka ‘Imi Na‘auao

‘A‘ole nō na‘e kēia mau hana ‘āpiki ‘o nā mea a pau loa, akā helu ‘ia kekahī ma lalo iho nei:

● Ka pākaha ‘ana, ka ‘aihue mana‘o, a i ‘ole nā hana ‘āpiki hou aku ma ka ‘imi na‘auao ‘ana.

He hana ‘āpiki ka pākaha ‘ana ma ka ‘imi na‘auao ‘ana i wehewehe ‘ia i lalo, akā nō na‘e, ‘a‘ole nō kēia ‘o nā hana a pau o ka pākaha ‘ana:

1. ke kōkua ‘ia mai e ka mea ‘āpono ‘ole ‘ia ma nā hō‘ike a me nā kuisa;
2. ka ho‘ohana ‘ana i nā kumu waiwai (kūmole) i ‘āpono ‘ole ‘ia e ke kumu i ke kākau pepa ‘ana, ka ho‘opalapala hō‘ike, ka ho‘omakala ‘ana ma ka pilihelu, a i ‘ole ka hana ‘ana i nā ha‘awina like ‘ole;
3. ka loa‘a ‘ana mai o ka hō‘ike a i ‘ole kekahī ha‘awina a ke kumu, ka limahana, a i ‘ole ka haumāna o ke kulanui ke ‘ole ka ‘ae ‘ia mai;
4. ka hana ‘ana i kekahī mea i pāpā ‘ia ma loko o ka Palapala Kuhikuhi Papa (‘Oloke‘a Papa) a i‘ole ke kūkākūkā a ka papa.

He hana ‘āpiki nō ho‘i ka ‘aihue mana‘o, akā nō na‘e, ‘a‘ole nō kēia ‘o nā hana a pau o ka ‘aihue mana‘o ‘ana:

1. ka ho‘ohana ‘ana, ma o ka wehewehe pōkole a i ‘ole ka puna‘ī, i ka hana a ha‘i, i pa‘i ‘ia a i ‘ole i pa‘i ‘ole ‘ia no ka lehulehu, ke ‘ole ke kuhikuhi piha a mōakāka iā ha‘i;
2. ka ho‘ohana ‘ana i ka pepa a i ‘ole kekahī mea e pili i ka ho‘ona‘auao i kū‘ai ‘ia a haku ‘ia e ka ‘oihana a i ‘ole ke kanaka ho‘okahi, ‘a‘ole na ka haumāna e koi ‘ia ai ka ha‘awina.

He mau hana ‘āpiki hou aku:

1. ka ho‘opunipuni ‘ana i ka luna, ke kumu a i ‘ole ke ke‘ena o ke kulanui
2. ke kākau ‘āpuka, ka ho‘ololi ‘ana, a i ‘ole ka ho‘ohana kūpono ‘ole i ka palapala, ka mo‘olelo, a i ‘ole ke kāleka pilikino a ke kulanui.

No ka Waihona Kōkua Ho‘ona‘auao

I ke kākau inoa ‘ana i nā papa, e ho‘omana‘o i ke kuleana o ke kulanui, a he kānāwai ho‘i ia, i ka hō‘oia ‘ana i ka ‘imi na‘auao ‘ana a nā haumāna i loa‘a mai ai ke kālā pekelalala ma lalo o Title IV no ke kōkua ‘ana i nā haumāna. Inā ‘a‘ole komo ka haumāna i loko o ka papa, a i ‘ole hō‘oki i ke komo ‘ana i ka papa, e koi ‘ia ana ka ho‘ihō‘i kālā ma lalo o ke kānāwai Title IV 34 CFR 668.21(a), a no laila, e ho‘ihō‘i nō ‘oe i ke kālā i loa‘a mai. Inā loli kou mana‘o a ‘a‘ole ‘oe e komo ana i ka papa āu i kākau inoa ai, e koi ‘ia ‘oe i ka hō‘ike ‘ana i kou mana‘o i ke ke‘ena waihona kōkua ho‘ona‘auao i ho‘ēmi ai i ka hopena ho‘opa‘i.

E kipa ‘oe i ke ke‘ena waihona kōkua ho‘ona‘auao o kāu kahua kula no kekahī ‘ike e pili i ke kālā no ka hele kulanui ‘ana. Nui nā ‘ano kōkua no ka hele kulanui ‘ana, e like me ke noi kālā, ka waihona kōkua ho‘ona‘auao, a pēlā wale aku nō. Na ke ka‘i e a‘oa‘o iā ‘oe i ke ki‘ina hana no kēia waihona kālā

Inā he hihia kou i ke kino, ka lonoa, ke olakino, ke akamai a i ‘ole ka no‘ono‘o pono e ili ana ma luna o ka ho‘okō pono i nā kuleana haumāna, paipai ‘ia ‘oe i ka hō‘ike i ke hihia i ke Ka‘i A‘oa‘o no nā Kanaka Hiki ‘Ole. Me ia nō ‘oe e wala‘au ai i ke kōkua kūpono no ka ho‘okō ‘ana i nā kuleana haumāna. No nā Kumu Waiwai (Kūmole) no ka Ho‘okae Keka a i ‘ole Hana Weliweli ma muli o ka Hō‘ike Keka (Title IX)

Pāpā ‘ia ka ho‘oka‘e e Title IX ma muli o ke keka i loko nā papahana ‘imi na‘auao a pau e loa‘a ana ke kālā pekelalala. He pāpā kiko‘ī ko Title IX i ka ho‘okae keka; ka ho‘opi‘oloke keka a i‘ole hō‘ike keka, a ma loko o kēia he ho‘opi‘oloke ma muli o ke keka i kuhi ‘ia, ka ‘i‘ini keka, ka hō‘ike keka; ka limanui keka; ke kāhina keka; hana weliweli ma ka ‘ohana; ka hana ho‘oweli ma ka pilina; a me ka ho‘omoho ‘ana. No ka ‘imi ‘ana i ka ‘ike e pili i kou pono ma lalo o Title IX, e kipa ma ‘ane‘i: [Kūpa‘a ke Kulanui Kaiāulu o ke Ko‘olau i ke kaulike ma ka ‘imi na‘auao. Inā ‘oe a i ‘ole kekahī kanaka kama‘āina iā ‘oe i ho‘okae keka ‘ia a i ‘ole hana weliweli ‘ia ma muli o ka hō‘ike keka, he mau mea ko kēia kulanui i ke kāko‘o ‘ana iā ‘oe.
